



Santa Barbara Sailing Club

Notice of Race Opening Day March 6th, 2010

1. Host and Organizing Authority

The regatta is hosted and organized by the **Santa Barbara Sailing Club**.

2. Rules

This race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, PHRF-SoCal class rules, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions. This race is a single-handed race, this modifies rule 10.5 of the PHRF-SoCal Class Rules.

3. Eligibility and Entry

All PHRF and single-class design yachts are eligible. Handicap ratings will be applied per PHRF certificate or by listing if not certified. Area Random Leg PHRF handicaps will be used. In order to be scored, PHRF certificates and listings must be verified and confirmed by the registration deadline. All entrants must be a member in good standing with a home club. All one-design entries shall be a member in good standing with their respective one-design class. All entrants are required to be a member of a sailing club or yacht club recognized by SCYA or other regional yachting association.

4. Safety Equipment

Standard safety equipment shall be carried.

5. Schedule of Events

All activities will take place as per dates above. Registration will be held between the hours of 1000 and 1200 hours at the Santa Barbara Sailing Club clubhouse. A skippers meeting will be held at the clubhouse at 1200 hours. The warning for the start of the race will be at 1325 hours. A social event will be held in the Santa Barbara Sailing Club boatyard after the day's racing.

Entrants must be a member in good standing with a yacht club or sailing club and must be able to produce proof of membership upon registration.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions in draft version will be available at www.sailsbsc.org. The final version of the sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. Racing Area and Course

The starting area will be located approximately .25 nm southwest of the entrance to the Santa Barbara Harbor. Further course detail will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Mooring

Mooring is available on a first come first serve bases in the Santa Barbara Harbor. Fees may apply.
